About the Faculty

The mission of the faculty is based on multidisciplinary study programmes, which educate, for instance, future diplomats, officials, managers and third sector employees. We teach methodology, provide scientific tools and teach languages so as to analyse reality. Students of the faculty have the opportunity to familiarise themselves with the multicultural world both during classes and international scholarships.

The interdisciplinarity of the faculty's research consists in combining the achievements of the humanities, social sciences and the broadly understood discipline of political science. The specificity of research also consists in its internationalisation. Research areas are classified both regionally – concerning, for instance, Europe, Asia, North and South America; as well as problematically – including, for instance, research on peace and security or political theory. Researchers of the faculty conduct international and national scientific projects in the fields of foreign policy of states, sub-state entities, ethnic, religious and cultural diversity.

Project “Operationalisation of the soundscape public value of the post-industrial cities”.

The aim of the project is to map urban areas and diagnose the impact of noise on the daily lives of residents of Lodz, Tampere and Manchester. The field of research concerns municipal institutions, residents and experts in the field of soundscape. The project manager is Dr Justyna Anders – Morawska.

Faculty of International and Political Studies of the University of Lodz is a member of the UL Interdisciplinary Centre for Urban Studies

The centre conducts scientific research, implements educational and popular science projects and cooperates with the broadly understood environment in the area of urban studies. The centre organises discussions with experts, runs counselling activity and prepares a series of publications

on urban issues. Dr. Justyna Anders - Morawska is the representative of the Faculty in the Scientific Council of the Centre.

Project “The role of cities in the European Union’s policy towards China”.

It is a study on the scale of cooperation between cities of the European Union (EU) and the People’s Republic of China (PRC). Based on a survey sent to the European cities with more than 50,000 residents, a map of China’s active partners in the EU will be created. Ten selected cities will be analysed in a more detailed manner considering, for example, motives for cooperation. The EU representatives will also be interviewed on the role of European cities in China’s policy. Dr hab. Tomasz Kamiński, professor at the University of Lodz is the project manager.
